## NEEDLES

4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle, no more than 80 [90: 100: 110: 120] cm long
5 mm (no 6) (US 8) circular needle, no more than 70 [80: 90: 100: 110] cm long
Set of 4 double-pointed 4 mm (no 8) (US 6) needles
Set of 4 double-pointed 5 mm (no 6) (US 8) needles
2.00 mm (no 14) (US B1) crochet hook

## TENSION

18 sts and 23 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 5 mm (US 8) needles and Kidsilk Haze.

## CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{c h}=$ chain; $\mathbf{d c}=$ double crochet; dtr $=$ double treble; $\mathbf{h t r}=$ half treble; $\mathbf{s p ( s )}=\operatorname{space}(\mathrm{s}) ; \mathbf{s s}=$ slip stitch; $\mathbf{t r}=$ treble.

BODY (worked in one piece)
Using 4 mm (US 6) circular needle and yarn A cast on 166 [182: 206: 226: 254] sts very loosely.

Taking care not to twist cast-on edge, work in rounds as folls:
Round 1 (RS): Knit.
Place marker after last st of this round to denote beg and end of rounds - this marker is at left side seam.
Round 2: Purl.
Rounds 3 and 4: As rounds 1 and 2.
Now, counting away from left side seam marker, place another marker to denote right side seam after next 83 [91:103:113:127] sts. 2 markers in total - one at left side seam (beg and end of rounds) and one at right side seam, with 83 [91:103:113:127] sts between markers.
Change to 5 mm (US 8) circular needle.

## Round 5: Knit.

This round forms st st.
Working in st st throughout, cont as folls:
Cont in rounds of st st until body meas 14 [15:16:18:19] cm.
Now shape side seams as folls:
Next round: (Sl 1, K1, psso, K to within 2 sts of next marker, K2tog, slip marker onto right needle) twice.
Working all side seam decreases as set by last round, dec 1 st at each side of both markers ( 4 sts decreased on each decrease round) on 8th and 4 foll 8 th rounds. 142 [158: 182: 202: 230] sts.
Work 9 rounds.
Next round: (K1, M1, K to within 1 st of next marker, M1, K1, slip marker onto right needle) twice.
Working all side seam increases as set by last round, inc 1 st at each side of both markers ( 4 sts increased on each increase round) on 4th and 4 foll 4th rounds. 166 [182: 206: 226: 254] sts.
Cont straight until body meas 49 [ $50: 51: 52: 53] \mathrm{cm}$.
Next round: K4 and slip these 4 sts onto a holder for left underarm, K75 [83:95:105:119] and slip these sts onto another holder for front, K8 and slip these 8 sts onto another holder for right underarm, K75 [83: 95: 105: 119] and slip these sts onto another holder for
back, K rem 4 sts and slip these 4 sts onto same holder as first 4 sts on left underarm holder -8 sts now on this underarm holder.
Break yarn.

## SLEEVES

Using set of double-pointed 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A cast on 50 [52: 54: 54: 56] sts.
Distribute sts evenly over 3 of the 4 needles and, using 4th needle, and taking care not to twist cast-on edge, work in rounds as folls:
Round 1 (RS): Knit.
Place marker after last st of this round to denote beg and end of rounds - this marker is at underarm (sleeve seam) point.
Round 2: Purl.
Rounds 3 and 4: As rounds 1 and 2.
Change to set of double-pointed 5 mm (US 8) needles.
Now work in rounds of st st as folls:
Cont straight until sleeve meas 20 [21:22: 22: 22] cm.
Next round: K1, M1, K to last st, M1, K1. 52 [54: 56: 56: 58] sts.
Working all increases as set by last round, inc 1 st at each end of 12th [12th: 8th: 8th: 6th] and 3 [3:4:5:3] foll 12th [12th: 10th: 8th: 6th] rounds, then on 0 [0:0:0:3] foll 8th rounds. 60 [62: 66:68:72] sts. Cont straight until sleeve meas 46 [47: 48: 48: 48$] \mathrm{cm}$.
Next round: K4 and slip these 4 sts onto a holder for underarm, K52 [54:58:60:64] and slip these sts onto another holder for sleeve, K4 and slip these 4 sts onto same holder as first 4 sts on underarm holder -8 sts now on this underarm holder.
Break yarn.

## YOKE

With RS facing, using 5 mm (US 8) circular needle and yarn A, work across sts on holders as folls: K across 52 [54:58:60:64] sts on one sleeve holder dec 1 st at centre, then 75 [83:95: 105:119] sts on front holder dec $1[0: 0: 0: 1]$ st at each end, 52 [54: 58: 60:64] sts on other sleeve holder dec 1 st at centre, and 75 [83: 95: 105: 119] sts on back holder dec $1[0: 0: 0: 1]$ st at each end.
248 [272: 304: 328: 360] sts.
Place marker after last st of this round to denote beg and end of rounds - this marker is at left back.
Now working in rounds of st st, cont as folls:
Cont straight until yoke meas 8 [9:10:11:12] cm from sts on underarm holders.
Next round: (K1, K2tog, K2, K2tog tbl, K1) 31 [34: 38: 41: 45] times. 186 [204: 228: 246: 270] sts.
(Note:When required as the number of sts decreases, change from circular needle to set of double-pointed needles.)
Cont straight until yoke meas 15 [16:17:18:19] cm from sts on underarm holders.
Next round: (K1, K2tog, K1, K2tog tbl) 31 [34: 38: 41: 45] times. 124 [136: 152: 164: 180] sts.
Cont straight until yoke meas 22 [23:24:25:26] cm from sts on underarm holders.
Next round: (K1, K2tog, K1) 31 [34:38: 41: 45] times.
93 [102: 114: 123: 135] sts.

## Work neckband

Change to set of double-pointed 4 mm (US 6) needles.
Next round: Knit.
Next round: Purl.
Rep last 2 rounds once more, then first of these rounds again.

Using a 5 mm (US 8) needle, cast off very loosely purlwise, ensuring cast-off edge has sufficient stretch to fit over head.

## MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.
Join underarm seams by grafting together the 2 sets of 8 sts left on underarm holders.
See information page for finishing instructions.

## Motif A (make 2)

Using 2.00 mm (US B1) crochet hook and yarn B, make 8 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.
Round 1: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), (1 dc into ring, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dtr}$ into ring, 3 ch ) 8 times, ss to first dc.
Round 2: Ss along and into top of first dtr, $\star 12 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ tr into 9 th ch from hook, 3 ch , miss ( $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 3 ch ), 1 ss into next dtr, rep from * to end, working ss at end of last rep into same dtr as last ss at beg of round.
Round 3: 1 ss into each of first 4 ch (last ch worked into in same ch as used for first tr of previous round), 3 ch (counts as 1 tr ), $\star(1$ htr, 7 dc and 1 htr ) into next ch sp, 1 tr into next tr, miss ( $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{ss}$ and 3 ch$)^{\star \star}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ into next ch , rep from $\star$ to end, ending last rep at $\star \star$, ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round.
Round 4:1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into "sp" created by tr at end of last round and 3 ch at beg of last round, $\star 3 \mathrm{ch}$, miss ( 1 tr , 1 htr and 1 dc$), 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 3 ch , miss $1 \mathrm{dc},(1 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}$ and 1 dc) into next dc, 3 ch , miss $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $\mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, miss ( 1 dc , 1 htr and $1 \operatorname{tr})^{\star \star}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ between tr just missed and next tr, rep from $\star$ to end, ending last rep at ${ }^{\star \star}$, ss to first dc.
Fasten off.

## Motif B (make 4)

Using 2.00 mm (US B1) crochet hook and yarn B, make 6 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.
Round 1:1 ch (does NOT count as st), 12 dc into ring, ss to first dc.

Round 2:3 ch (counts as 1 tr ), 1 tr into dc at base of $3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ into each of next 11 dc , ss to top of 3 ch at beg of round. 24 sts.
Round 3:1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch , 1 dc into each of next 23 tr , ss to first dc.
Round 4:1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch , $\star 5 \mathrm{ch}$, miss $2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, rep from * to end, replacing dc a end of last rep with ss to first dc. 8 ch sps.
Round 5:1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into st at base of 1 ch , * ( $1 \mathrm{htr}, 3 \mathrm{tr}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ ss into first of these $4 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ ss into same ch as used for last ss, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ ss into same ch as used for last ss, 3 tr and 1 htr) into next ch sp, 1 dc into next dc, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end, replacing dc at end of last rep with ss to first dc.
Fasten off.
Motif C (make 4)
Using 2.00 mm (US B1) crochet hook and yarn B, make 8 ch and join with a ss to form a ring.
Round 1: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 16 dc into ring, ss to first dc.

Round 2: 12 ch (counts as 1 dtr and 8 ch ), miss dc at base of 12 ch and next dc, ${ }^{\star} 1$ dtr into next dc, 8 ch , miss 1 dc , rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end, ss to 4th of 12 ch at beg of round.
Round 3: 1 ch (does NOT count as st), $\begin{gathered}\text { ( } 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{tr} \text { and } 3\end{gathered}$ dtr) into next ch sp, $4 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ ss to top of last dtr, ( $2 \mathrm{dtr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ and 1 dc ) into same ch sp as previous sts, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end, ss to dc at
beg of round.
Fasten off.

## Motif D (make 8)

Using 2.00 mm (US B1) crochet hook and yarn B, make 17 ch.
Row 1: 1 dc into 3 rd ch from hook, 1 dc into each of next $13 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ into last ch, now working back along other side of base ch, work 1 dc into each of next 15 ch , turn.
Row 2: 1 ch , miss first dc, 1 dc into each dc to last 3 dc , working 3 dc into centre dc of 3-dc group of previous row, turn.
Rep last row 5 times more.
Fasten off.
Using photograph as a guide, arrange motifs over front and shoulder areas of garment and neatly sew in place.


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
