NEEDLES

1 pair 3³/₄mm (no 9) (US 5) needles 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

BUTTONS - 3

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4mm (US 6) needles.

BACK

Using 3 ³ /mm (US 5) needles cast on 95 [105: 119: 133] sts.			
Row 1 (RS): K1 [0: 1: 2], P3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last			
1 [0: 1: 2] sts, K1 [0: 1: 2].			
Row 2 : P1 [0: 1: 2], K3, *P3, K3, rep from * to last 1 [0: 1: 2] sts			
P1 [0: 1: 2].			
These 2 rows form rib.			
Work in rib for a further 20 rows, ending with RS facing for			
next row.			
Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.			
Row 23 (RS): Purl.			
Row 24 : K1 [0:1:0], * K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 2 [1:2:1] sts,			
K2 [1: 2: 1].			
Beg with a P row, cont in rev st st until back meas 34 [35: 36: 37] cm,			
ending with RS facing for next row.			
Shape raglan armholes			
Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 89 [99: 113: 127] sts.			
Sizes S and M only			
Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog,			
yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 6 sts, yrn, P2tog tbl (for eyelet			
hole), K2tog (for raglan dec), K2.			
Next row: P3, K to last 3 sts, P3.			
Next row : K3, P2tog, yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 5 sts, yrn,			
P2tog tbl (for eyelet hole), K3.			
Next row: P3, K to last 3 sts, P3.			
Rep last 4 rows 3 [0: -: -] times more. 81 [97: -: -] sts.			
Sizes L and XL only			
Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog,			
yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 6 sts, yrn, P2tog tbl (for eyelet			
hole), K2tog (for raglan dec), K2.			
Next row: P2, P2tog, K to last 4 sts, P2tog tbl, P2.			

Rep last 2 rows - [-: 3: 8] times more. - [-: 97: 91] sts. **All sizes**

Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog, yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 6 sts, yrn, P2tog tbl (for eyelet hole), K2tog (for raglan dec), K2.

Next row: P3, K to last 3 sts, P3.

Rep last 2 rows 14 [22: 21: 18] times more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 51 [51: 53: 53] sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3³/₄mm (US 5) needles cast on 44 [49: 56: 63] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 [0: 1: 2], *P3, K3, rep from * to last st, K1. **Row 2**: K1, *P3, K3, rep from * to last 1 [0: 1: 2] sts, P1 [0: 1: 2]. These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 20 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Row 23 (RS): Purl.

Row 24: *K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 2 [1: 2: 1] sts, K2 [1: 2: 1].

Beg with a P row, cont in rev st st until left front matches back to beg of raglan armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row. 41 [46: 53: 60] sts. Work 1 row.

Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog, yrn (for eyelet hole), P to end.

Working all raglan armhole decreases and eyelet holes as set by last row and as for back, cont as folls:

Dec 1 st at raglan armhole edge of 4th [4th: next: next] and foll 0 [0:7:17] rows, then on 3 [0:0:0] foll 4th rows, then on foll 5 [13:11:8] alt rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row. 31 [31: 33: 33] sts.

Shape front neck

Keeping patt correct, cast off 13 sts at beg of next row. 18 [18: 20: 20] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 9 rows, then on foll 0 [0: 1: 1] alt row **and at same time** dec 1 st at raglan armhole edge of next and foll 4 [4: 5: 5] alt rows. 4 sts.

Work 1 row. Next row (RS): K1, sl 1, K2tog, psso. Next row: P2.

Next row: K2tog and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3³/₄mm (US 5) needles cast on 44 [49: 56: 63] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 1 [0: 1: 2] sts, K1 [0: 1: 2].

Row 2: P1 [0: 1: 2], *****K3, P3, rep from ***** to last st, K1. These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 20 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Row 23 (RS): Purl.

Row 24: K1 [0: 1: 0], *K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last st, K1. Beg with a P row, cont in rev st st and complete to match left front, reversing shapings. SLEEVES

Using 3³/₄mm (US 5) needles cast on 53 [55: 57: 59] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1 [2: 3: 1], P3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last 1 [2: 3: 1] sts, K1 [2: 3: 1].

Row 2: P1 [2: 3: 1], K3, *P3, K3, rep from * to last 1 [2: 3: 1] sts, P1 [2: 3: 1].

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 14 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Row 17 (RS): Inc in first st, P to last st, inc in last st. 55 [57: 59: 61] sts.

Row 18: *K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last st, K1.

Beg with a P row, cont in rev st st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 4th row to 61 [67: 65: 73] sts, then on every foll 6th row until there are 75 [79: 81: 85] sts. Cont straight until sleeve meas 28 [29: 30: 30] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 69 [73: 75: 79] sts.

Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog, yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 6 sts, yrn, P2tog tbl (for eyelet hole), K2tog (for raglan dec), K2.

Next row: P2, P2tog, K to last 4 sts, P2tog tbl, P2.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 61 [65: 67: 71] sts.

Next row (RS): K2, sl 1, K1, psso (for raglan dec), P2tog, yrn (for eyelet hole), P to last 6 sts, yrn, P2tog tbl (for eyelet hole), K2tog (for raglan dec), K2.

Next row: P3, K to last 3 sts, P3.

Rep last 2 rows 17 [19: 20: 22] times more. 25 sts.

Keeping raglan decreases and eyelet holes correct as set, cont as folls:

Left sleeve only

Dec 1 st at each end of next row, then cast off 4 sts at beg of foll row. 19 sts.

Dec 1 st at beg of next row, then cast off 5 sts at beg of foll row. 13 sts.

Dec 1 st at beg of next row, then cast off 6 sts at beg of foll row.

Right sleeve only

Cast off 5 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. 19 sts. Work 1 row.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 13 sts.

Cast off 6 sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row.

Work 1 row.

Both sleeves

Cast off rem 6 sts.

MAKING UP

Press.

Join all raglan armhole seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing and using 3 3/4mm (US 5) needles, pick up and knit 24 [24: 26: 26] sts up right side of neck, 19 sts from top of right sleeve, 51 [51: 53: 53] sts from back, 19 sts from top of left sleeve, then 24 [24: 26: 26] sts down left side of neck. 137 [137: 143: 143] sts.

Row 1 (WS): K1, P3, *K3, P3, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: K4, *****P3, K3, rep from ***** to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Button band

With RS facing and using 3^{/4}mm (US 5) needles, pick up and knit 119 [125: 125: 131] sts evenly down left front opening edge, from top of neckband to cast-on edge.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for neckband for 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Buttonhole band

With RS facing and using 3⁴/₄mm (US 5) needles, pick up and knit 119 [125: 125: 131] sts evenly up right front opening edge, from cast-on edge to top of neckband.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for neckband for 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Row 2 (RS): Rib to last 55 sts, *cast off 2 sts (to make a buttonhole – cast on 2 sts over these cast-off sts on next row), rib until there are 22 sts on right needle after cast-off, rep from

* once more, cast off 2 sts (to make 3rd buttonhole – cast on 2 sts over these cast-off sts on next row), rib to end.

Work in rib for a further 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.
